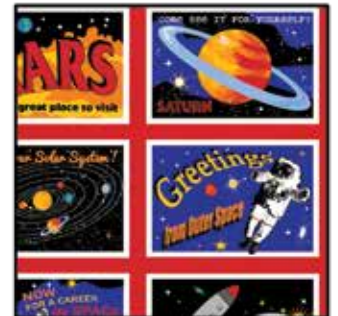

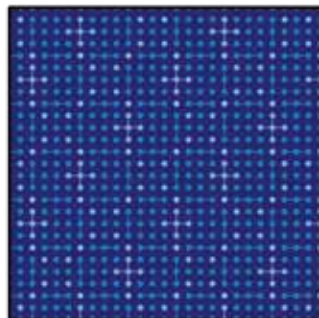

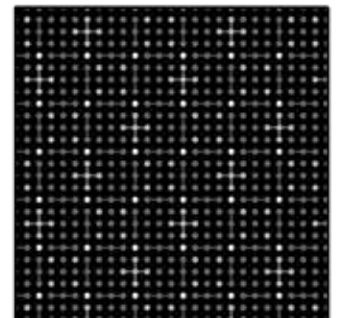

Materials

1 panel	Solar Chart-Glow in the Dark - Black (A)	9026PG-99
1/3 yard	Diodes - Blue (B)	9032-77
1 3/4 yards	Astronauts-Glow in the Dark - Black (C)	9028G-99
1 2/3 yards	Tossed Postcards - Black (D)	9033G-99
1 2/3 yards	Starlet - Red (E)	6383-Red

You will also need:

- 66" x 57" piece of batting
- 3 yards of sew-on Velcro

Cutting Instructions

Please Note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Solar Chart-Glow in the Dark - Black (A), fussy cut:

- (1) 33 1/2" x 42 1/2" panel.

From the Diodes - Blue (B), cut:

- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 66 1/2" strips.

From the Astronauts-Glow in the Dark - Black (C), cut:

- (1) 33 1/2" x 42 1/2" rectangle.
- (4) 6 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end and cut (2) 6 1/2" x 66 1/2" strips.

From the Tossed Postcards - Black (D), cut:

- (1) 33 1/2" x 57 1/2" rectangle from Length of Fabric (LOF).

From the Starlet - Red (E), cut:

- (1) 33 1/2" x 57 1/2" rectangle from LOF.

Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) 33 1/2" x 42 1/2" Fabric A rectangle to the right side of (1) 33 1/2" x 42 1/2" Fabric C rectangle to make Unit 1 (Fig. 1).

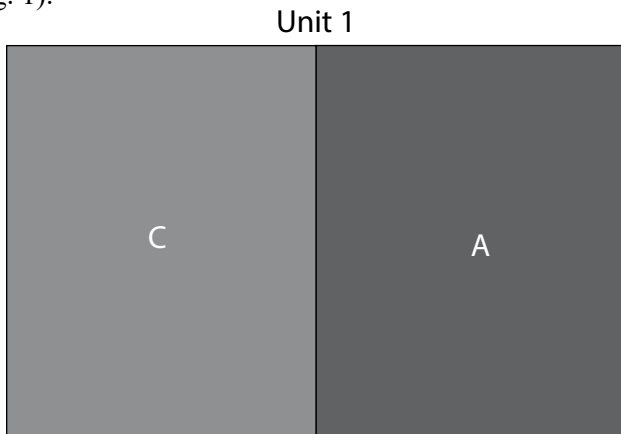

2. Sew (1) 2" x 66 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of Unit 1. Sew (1) 6 1/2" x 66 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and bottom of Unit 1 to make sleeping bag exterior (Fig. 2).

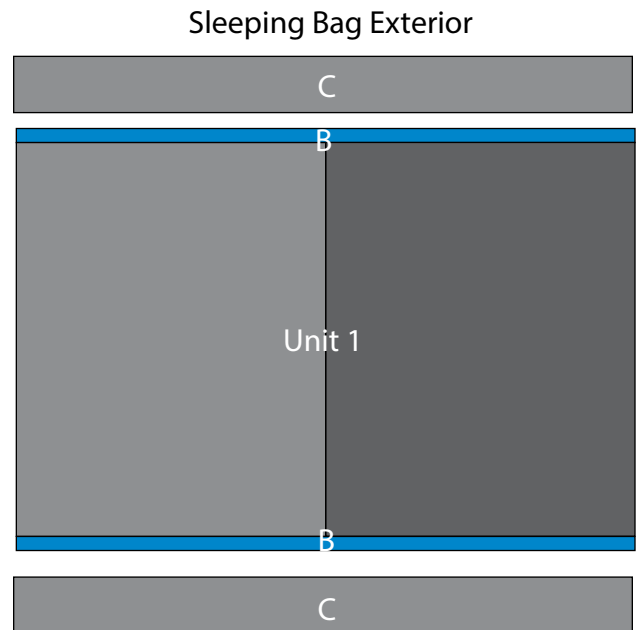

3. Sew (1) 33 1/2" x 57 1/2" Fabric D rectangle to the right side of (1) 33 1/2" x 57 1/2" Fabric E rectangle to make the sleeping bag interior (Fig. 3).

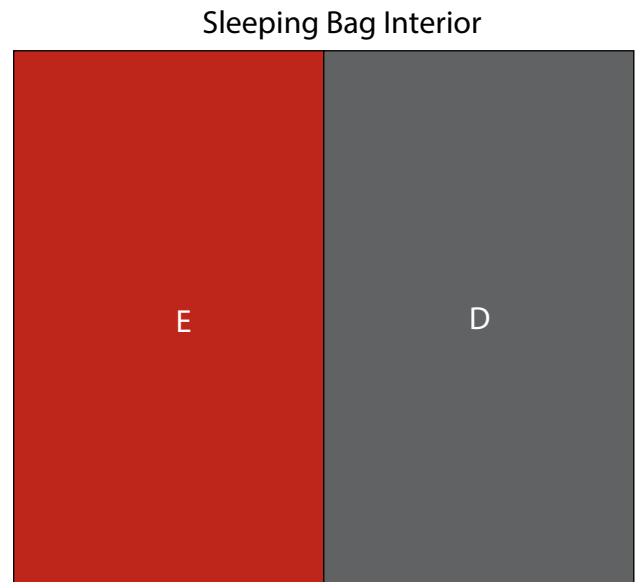

4. For the closure, position one half of the Velcro along the bottom and right side of Fabric D on the sleeping bag interior 1" from the edge and stitch in place. Repeat with the second half of the Velcro and the left and bottom side of the Fabric E sleeping bag interior (Fig. 4).

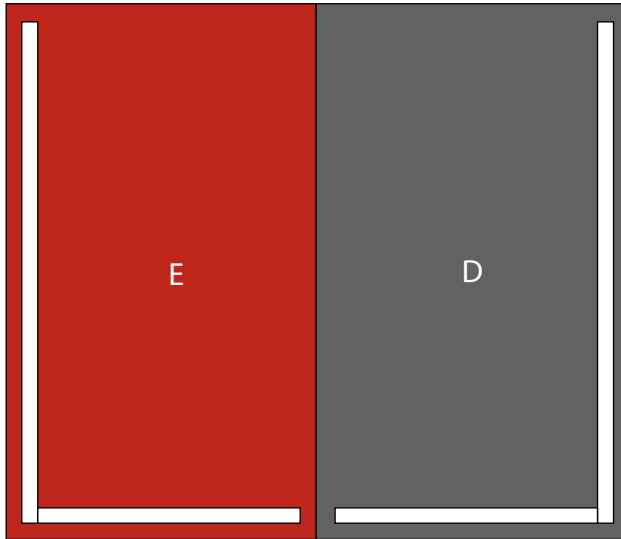

5. Place one piece of 33 1/2" x 57 1/2" batting down on a flat surface. Place the sleeping bag exterior on top of the batting, right side facing up, aligning the edges. Place the sleeping bag interior on top of the exterior, right side facing down. Pin the three layers together.

6. Sew around the edges of the layered fabric and batting leaving a 4" to 5" opening for turning. Turn the sleeping bag right side out.

7. Press the opening and top stitch around the outer edges. Quilt as desired.
