Finished Sizes:

Large: 12" x 16" (30.48cm x 40.64cm) Medium: 11" x 15" (27.94cm x 38.1cm) Small: 9" x 11" (22.86cm x 27.94cm) Mini: 6½" x 9" (16.51cm x 22.86cm)

Supplies Needed

- 8 Coordinating fat quarters (18" x 21", 45.72cm x53.34cm) 2 for each Pillow
- 1 pc Black felt: 9" x 12" (22.86cm x 30.48cm)
- 1 pc Pink felt: 3" x 3" (7.62cm x 7.62cm)
- Coordinating thread
- 1 bag Polyester fiberfill
- 1 bag Poly-pellets: 32 oz.
- 4 Plastic storage bags: snack size
- Craft glue
- Wooden dowel or chopstick
- Basic Sewing Supplies
- Sewing machine
- Iron and pressing surface

Before you begin


Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not prewash fabrics. Before cutting, press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting. Use a ¼" (6.35mm) seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Backstitch at the beginning and ending of stitching. Print Raindrop Patterns and Templates at 100% scale. *Note: Check measurements after printing to ensure correct print size.*

Cutting

- 1. Cut patterns and templates out along outside printed edge.
- 2. Fold a fat quarter **wrong** sides together so 21" (53.34cm) edges meet. Place pattern on fold and pin to fabric; cut out along edge of pattern. Repeat for matching fat quarter.



- 3. Refer to Diagram A to begin sewing along one side at the bottom edge and sew around the edge to the other side ending at the bottom. *Note: Bottom edge is left open for inserting the poly-fill stuffing and pellets.*
- 4. Turn Pillow right side out and gently push out point with dowel or chopstick; press edges flat.
- 5. Insert poly-fill through opening. *Note*: *Stuff firmly but do not overstuff*.
- 6. Fill a snack bag with a handful of poly-pellets and place in the bottom of the pillow. Add more poly-fill and pin opening closed: hand stitch.





Finishing


7. Pin face features to felt and cut around outside edge. Refer to photo to place on Raindrop Pillow or place as desired. Glue to secure and allow to dry completely.


Finished Care Instructions


Machine wash cold water, lay flat or hang to dry
