## Materials

1 panel Bears in Blocks - White/Multi (A) F1207-16
1 yard Dots - White/Yellow (B) F1203-4
$11 / 4$ yards Large Stripe - Yellow/Turq. (C) F1202-41
$1 / 4$ yard Stars - Pink (D)
F1206-22
$1 / 2$ yard Dots - Turquoise (E) F1203-11*
3 yards Bears \& Stars on Small Boxes - White/Multi (Backing) F1201-16
*Includes binding.

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Bears in Blocks - White/Multi (A), fussy cut: - (12) $71 / 2 "$ blocks.

From the Dots - White/Yellow (B), cut:

- (5) $21 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $21 / 2 "$ x $71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- (8) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $21 / 2 "$ x $111 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Large Stripe - Yellow/Turq. (C), fussy cut:

- (2) $10 \frac{1}{2} " \times$ WOF strips, centered on the blue stripe. Sub-cut (15) $31 / 2 " \times 101 / 2 "$ blue strips.
- (2) $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ WOF strips, centered on the yellow stripe. Sub-cut (16) $31 / 2 " \times 101 / 2 "$ yellow strips.

From the Stars - Pink (D), cut:
-(2) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) $31 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Dots - Turquoise (E), cut:
-(5) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Bears \& Stars on Small Boxes - White/Multi (Backing), cut:

- (2) 50 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 50 " x 63 " back.


## Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 71 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $71 / 2 "$ Fabric A block. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 111 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A block. Trim the block to measure $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (12) Block One squares total.

2. Sew (4) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric D squares and (3) $31 / 2 " \times 10 \frac{1}{2}$ " blue strips together end to end and alternating them to make (1) Sashing Row. Repeat to make (5) Sashing Rows total.

## Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)
3. Sew (4) $31 / 2 " \times 101 / 2 "$ Fabric C yellow strips and (3)

Block One squares together, alternating them, to make (1)
Pieced Row. Repeat to make (4) Pieced Rows total.
4. Sew the (5) Sashing Rows and (4) Pieced Rows together, alternating them, to make the quilt top.
5. Layer and quilt as desired.
6. Sew the (5) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric E strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
7. Bind as desired.
