Runner Block Assembly
Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Place (1) $3^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric C square on the left side of (1) $31 / 2 " \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A strip, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance (Fig. 2).

2. Place (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric $B$ square on the right side of the $3^{1 / 2 "} \times 6^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric A strip, right sides together (Fig. 3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 4).
3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (8) Unit 1 strips total.
4. Repeat Steps $1-2$ and refer to Figure 5 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (8) Unit 2 strips.

5. Sew (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric C square to the left side of (1) $31 / 2$ " Fabric E square. Sew the newly sewn strip to the top of (1) Unit 1 strip lengthwise to make (1) $61 / 2 "$ Unit 3 square (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (8) Unit 3 squares total.
6. Sew (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric C square to the left side of (1) $31 / 2$ " Fabric F square. Sew the newly sewn strip to the top of (1) Unit 2 strip lengthwise to make (1) $61 / 2 "$ Unit 4 square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (8) Unit 4 squares total.

## Runner Assembly <br> (Follow the Runner Layout in Figure 9 while assembling the runner top.)

8. Sew together (4) Block One squares to make the Center Block.
9. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip to each end of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 501 / 2$ " Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
10. Sew (1) $41 / 2 "$ x $141 / 2$ " Fabric H strip to each end of the Center Block. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 581 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the Runner Top (Fig. 9).
11. Layer and quilt as desired.
12. Sew the (5) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric G strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
13. Bind as desired.

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Birds and Flowers - Cream/Red (A), cut:
-(2) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $31 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ strips.
From the Rose Bud Toss - Carrot (B), cut:
-(2) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) $31 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Folio Basic - Off White (C), cut:

- (3) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) $31 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Feather Lattice - Cream/Red (D), cut:

- (2) $31 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $31 / 2 " \times 6 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Spring Bias Plaid - Red (E), cut:

- (1) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $31 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Tiny Calico - Red (F), cut:
-(1) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $31 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Spring Bias Plaid - Green (G), cut:

- (3) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $11 / 2 "$ x $121 / 2 "$ strips.
- (4) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 141 / 2 "$ strips.
-(8) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Novelty Toss - Light Blue (H), cut:
- (4) $31 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $31 / 2 " \times 141 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Rose Bud Toss - Cream (Backing), cut:
-(2) 24 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) $24 " \times 18 "$ strips for the backings.

Place Mat Assembly
Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.
14. Place (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric C square on the left side of (1) $31 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric A strip, right sides together (Fig. 10). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 10). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance (Fig. 11).

15. Place (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric B square on the right side of the $31 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric A strip, right sides together (Fig. 12). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 12). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 5 strip (Fig. 13).
16. Repeat Steps 14-15 to make (8) Unit 5 strips total.

17. Repeat Steps 14-15 and refer to Figure 14 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (8) Unit 6 strips.

19. Sew (1) $3^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric $C$ square to the left side of (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric F square. Sew the newly sewn strip to the top of (1) Unit 6 strip lengthwise to make (1) $61 / 2 "$ Unit 8 square (Fig. 16). Repeat to make (8) Unit 8 squares total.

22. Sew (1) $31 / 2 " \times 14^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric H strip to each side of (1) Unit 10 square to make (1) Place Mat Top (Fig. 19). Repeat to make (4) Place Mat Tops total.

24. Sew the (8) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric G strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press. Cut the strip into (4) equal parts.
25. Bind as desired.
